Important instructions:

- Read the following deck of slides closely and carefully all the way to the end <u>before</u> you start creating your UCAS account.
- Ensure that all information provided by you is truthful to the best of your knowledge.
- It is the responsibility of applicants to ensure self-reported results are entered correctly.
- Key in your Secondary 4 end of year results under "Secondary School" section for RP students.
- Secondary 3 results are not required.

Applying to UK Universities: Overview

- Start your UCAS account online. (Instructions provided in the following slides.)
- 2. Approach your CT directly to request for a recommendation.
- Read university websites for detailed course outlines and admission requirements.
- 4. Register and sit for admission tests, where relevant.
- 5. Complete and submit your UCAS application well before given internal deadline.
- 6. Double-check your UCAS application carefully (name, subjects listed, etc.) before you click submit.

<u>Note:</u> Certain universities & courses have additional requirements. Read the application instructions of your desired universities/courses closely.

Important information: UCAS

- You submit 1 personal statement for all your course choices. Hence all your course choices must be within a similar field.
- You send off your UCAS statement <u>once</u>. i.e., if you are applying for courses with early deadlines, you will submit your UCAS application to all other courses/unis in your list by Sep/Oct.
- You can make a max. of 5 course choices with the <u>following exception</u>:
 - ❖ Up to 4 course choices for Med/VetMed/VetSci/Dentistry. You can include a 5th choice in another related course. E.g. You may apply for 4 Med courses and 1 Biomedical Sciences course.
- You can only make <u>1 course choice in either Cambridge or Oxford</u>, not both.
- Universities will consider all applications submitted by the UCAS deadline. They cannot see where else you have applied to.
- Payment is made directly to UCAS online, not through the school.

Important guidelines to follow

- The buzzword for this cycle is <u>2021Raffles</u>
- You can start your accounts from 31 July 2020.
 Note that completed applications can only be submitted to UCAS from 8 September 2020.
- You need to have <u>1 reference</u> submitted in support of your application. Your reference is written and submitted by your <u>Civics</u> <u>Tutor</u>. For classes with 2 CTs, your CTs will decide whom writes for you.
- You need to complete your UCAS statement and make payment <u>before</u> your CT can complete his/her portion and send your application off. So, be sure to complete your application well ahead of our <u>internal deadlines</u>.
- Plan ahead. It is your responsibility to adhere to RI deadlines.
- You have to apply <u>through RI</u> as your school, in order for us to process and submit your application.

Important guidelines to follow

- Approach your CT <u>personally</u> for a reference based on our internal timeline. <u>Do not wait till you are done with your statement</u>.
- Furnish your CT with a 1-page write-up with information on:
 - Your academic interests, e.g. the topic you enjoyed most, etc. and why
 - Academic enrichment activities, where available.
 - Non-academic activities
 - Any other information requested by your CT







Education: Adding Year 4 Qualifications (RGS Girls)




Education: Adding Year 4 English Qualifications (IP students)

Additional Information: Tests and Requirements

- Check the <u>entry requirements</u> for the courses you are applying to on university websites. Some require that you sit additional aptitude or entry tests prior to submitting your application.
- Due to the uncertainty of COVID-19 situation, do refer to https://www.admissionstesting.org/campaigns/coronavirus/ for the latest updates on tests information.
- Several Law and Medicine programmes require applicants to sit for the LNAT and BMAT/ UCAT respectively.
- Be aware of the test dates and plan ahead accordingly.
- English Language qualifications and IELTS: you may have to sit for the test in 2021 depending on conditions set by the different universities in your offer letters next year.

UK Admissions Test (Law)_LNAT https://lnat.ac.uk/

- An admissions test used by Law programmes in some universities. Check university websites on their application/admission requirements.
- Registration: From 1 August 2020.
- Testing dates: From 1 September 2020.

NOTE: Oxford deadlines

- 15 Sep 2020: Last day to register and book your LNAT slot.
- 15 Oct 2020: Sit the LNAT before or on 15 Oct 2020 at the very latest.

Deadlines for all other LNAT universities besides Oxford

- 15 Jan 2021: Register & book LNAT test slot
- 20 Jan 2021: Sit LNAT before or on this date

Register directly via RELC website, not through RI.

You can take the LNAT before or after you submit your UCAS application.

Date of test: 4 Nov 2020

- For Med, VetMed, Biomed Sci & Dentistry courses at certain universities.
- Students applying to the LKC School of Medicine in 2020 <u>must</u> also sit for the BMAT test.

Registration

- Registration opens on 1 Sep 2020.
 - Register well before standard deadline. Check BMAT website for updates.
 - Cambridge applicants: Earlier deadline. Register as soon as it opens, in order to be in time for the early submission of your UCAS & COPA.
- Register <u>directly</u> via RELC website, not through RI. *(Select RI as your test centre at the dropdown list for current students)
- BMAT fees: Provisions are made for students who are on MOE FAS. Email Ms Joyce Tan at joyce.tan@ri.edu.sg for clarifications on MOE FAS subsidy.
