



- 3. Note earlier deadlines for submission of UCAS applications.



Registration period: 1 Sep 2020 – 15 Oct 2020

Date of tests: Not published yet. Check RELC website for updates.

- Check uni and testing websites for the relevant admissions test.
- Take note of the deadlines for the test relevant to you. Complete your registration well ahead of deadlines.
- MUST have your UCAS ID before you register for admissions tests.
- Admission tests results are <u>ONLY</u> valid for the year of application.

A note on Cambridge written assessments:

- Pre-interview: Takes place after your interview, on dates to be confirmed.
- At-interview: Takes place on dates to be confirmed.

Registration

- Registration opens on 1 Sep 2020.
 - Check registration dates/details on RELC website.
 - Camb applicants interviewing in SGP: Register as soon as it opens, in order to be in time for the early submission of your UCAS & COPA (8 Sep).
- Register <u>directly</u> via RELC website, not through RI. Select RI as your physical test centre at the dropdown list (if applicable).
- BMAT fees: Provisions are made for students who are on MOE FAS.

Admission Test_LNAT

- Registration: From 1 August 2020
- Testing dates: From 1 September 2020

NOTE: Oxford deadlines

- 1 Aug 15 Sep 2020: Register and book your LNAT slot.
- 15 Oct 2020: Sit the LNAT before or on 15 Oct 2020 at the very latest.

You can take the LNAT before or after you send off your UCAS application.

<u>Update from Cambridge website:</u>

In order to minimise COVID-related risks to our applicants, students and staff in the coming undergraduate admissions round, we are not planning to conduct any overseas interviews in person this year in the countries in which we usually interview (Singapore, Malaysia (Kuala Lumpur), PR China (Shanghai), Hong Kong, India (Mumbai) and Canada (Toronto)). Written Work Requirements


Oxford submission of written work

- Check the specific course page for written work requirements.
- Cover page to be endorsed by your relevant academic teacher.

Cambridge submission of written work

- Usually due in 1st week of November where relevant. You will receive instructions from the relevant Cambridge college.
- Check the specific course page for written work requirements.
- Cover page to be endorsed by your relevant academic teacher.
