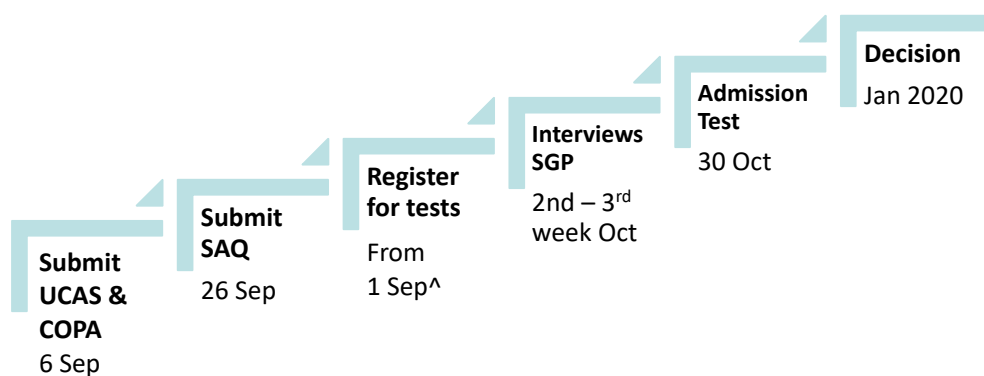

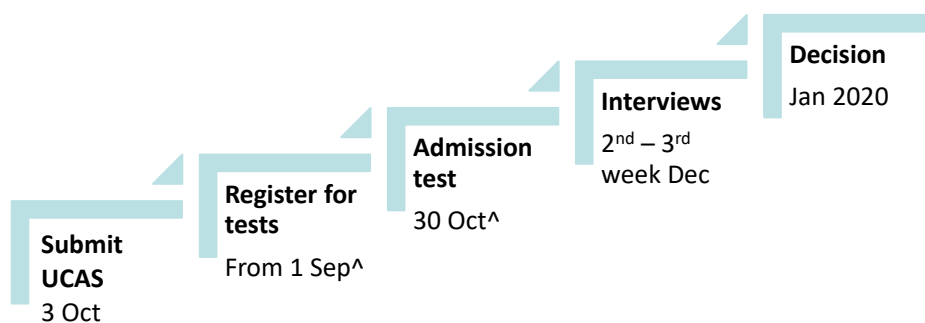
Applying to Cambridge: Overview (Interviewing in Singapore)

Applying to Oxbridge: Key notes

1. **Y6 students:** register with Higher Ed Office in person from 1 – 23 August.
2. **Alumni:** Register via this link: https://forms.ri.edu.sg//oxbridge_registration_alumni
3. Research and decide on **college choice** or put in an “open” application.
4. Note earlier deadlines for submission of UCAS applications.

5. Only for Cambridge: Submit UCAS + **COPA with uploaded results slips**. Refer to COPA Guide on IVY. Submit **SAQ** as instructed by specific college.
6. Register and sit for **admission tests**, as necessary.
7. Attend an **interview**.
 - Cambridge interviews: 2nd – 3rd week of October.
 - Oxford online interviews: 1st – 2nd week of December.
8. Submit **written work** as instructed by specific Oxbridge college.

- Register from **1 – 23 August 2019**.
- **Year 6 students:** Register with Higher Education Office in person.

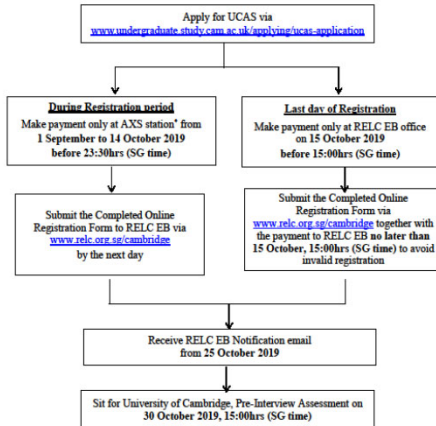

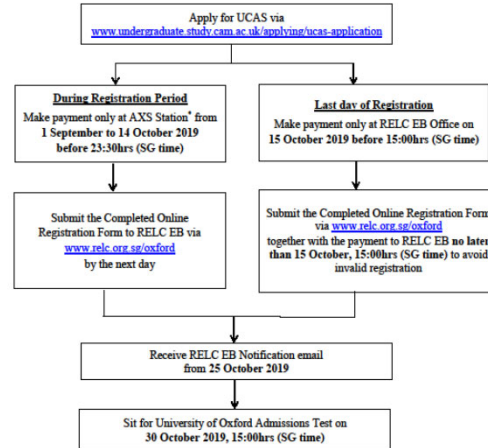
OVERVIEW OF REGISTRATION PROCESS

Register on RELC website directly. The registration is not done through us.

Registration period: 1 Sep 2019 – 15 Oct 2019

Date of tests: 30 October 2019

- Check uni and testing websites for the relevant admissions test.
- Take note of the deadlines for the test relevant to you. Complete your registration well ahead of deadlines.
- MUST have your UCAS ID before you register for admissions tests.
- Admission tests results are **ONLY** valid for the year of application.

A note on Cambridge written assessments:

- Pre-interview: Takes place *after* your interview, on **30 October 2019**.
- At-interview: Takes place in **mid-October 2019** with your interview.

Registration

- Registration opens on 1 Sep 2019.
 - Standard registration: 1 Sep – 29 Sep
 - **Registration deadline for Camb med applicants: 1 Oct**
 - **Camb applicants interviewing in SGP: Register as soon as it opens, in order to be in time for the early submission of your UCAS & COPA (6 Sep).**
- Register directly via RELC website, not through RI. Select RI as your test centre at the dropdown list.
- BMAT fees: Provisions are made for students who are on MOE FAS. Email Ms Joyce Tan at joyce.tan@ri.edu.sg for clarifications on MOE FAS subsidy.

Admission Test_LNAT
(<https://lnat.ac.uk/>)

- Registration: From 1 August 2019.
- Testing dates: From 1 September 2019.

NOTE: Oxford deadlines

- 5 October 2019: Register and book your LNAT slot.
- 20 Oct 2019: Sit the LNAT before or on 20 Oct 2019 at the very latest.

You can take the LNAT before or after you send off your UCAS application.

Part II: Interviews

Oxbridge Interviews

OXFORD INTERVIEWS

- Usually 1st 2 weeks of December (TBC).
- Note that you'll have to travel to Oxford for interviews for some courses.
- **Indicate clearly where you'd like to have your interviews in your application materials and correspondence with Oxford.**

CAMBRIDGE INTERVIEWS

- Usually 2nd – 3rd week of October (Singapore).
- Usually 1st 3 weeks of December (Cambridge).
- **Indicate where you'd like to have your interviews in your application materials (incl. COPA) and correspondence with Cambridge.**

IMPORTANT

- **Use your PERSONAL EMAIL ADDRESS in all application materials.**
- **Check your emails regularly once you've submitted your materials. Correspond promptly with universities and note your important dates.**

Part III: Written Work Submission

Written Work Requirements

Oxford submission of written work

- Usually due by 10 November where relevant.
- Check the specific course page for written work requirements.
- Cover page to be endorsed by your relevant academic teacher.

Cambridge submission of written work

- Usually due in 1st week of November where relevant. You will receive instructions from the relevant Cambridge college.
- Check the specific course page for written work requirements.
- Cover page to be endorsed by your relevant academic teacher.
