RI Sports Criteria

► You must be able to demonstrate an interest and talent in sports and games beyond the abilities of children in your age group.

or

► You must have a record of accomplished performance in sports and games at national schools, national and/or international levels.

Required Commitment

► Successful applicants for the Sports domain are required to join the CCA of the talent area they are accepted in.

ANNEX A: MINIMUM CRITERIA FOR SPECIFIC SPORTS

► To help you decide if you should apply for a particular sports talent area, we have listed the *minimum* criteria which you should have attained in the specific sport.

► Applicants may not be shortlisted for an interview even when they meet the minimum criteria. The final shortlist will be decided based on the ranking of all applicants according to their sports trials, sporting achievements and academic results.

► If you have not met these minimum criteria, you may still apply but you will very likely not be shortlisted unless there is other clear evidence of your skills as reflected in your DSA application. →

| DSA Sports | Minimum Criteria |

| Badminton | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Participated in 2023 Inter-Primary School Badminton NSG and in the starting line-up, OR- Participated in a local tournament (singles or doubles) and achieved a Top 4 placing - e.g. Pilot Pen Championship. |
| Basketball | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Participated in 2023 Inter-Primary School Basketball NSG and in the starting line-up for the competition. |
| Cricket | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Participated in a sanctioned hardball tournament in 2023, OR currently training or had past training with a cricket academy. |
| Cross Country | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Participated in any long distance events at the National Inter-Primary School Track & Field Meet (NSG) 2023 or any official Track & Field competition and achieved a Top 8 placing in at least 1 individual event. |
| Judo | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- 3rd MON grading achieved OR- Participation record in an official and recognised SJF Judo Competition in 2023. |
| Hockey | <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Participated in 2023 Inter-Primary School Hockey NSG and in the starting line-up of the competition, OR- Participated in any SHF age group competition- Active Participant in ActiveSG Hockey Academy |
| Rugby | <p><u>Applicants from schools with Rugby CCA</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Participated in 2023 Inter-Primary School Rugby NSG and in the starting line-up for the competition. <p><u>Applicants from schools without Rugby CCA</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Trained and competed in club competitions under external junior rugby clubs in 2023 |
