RULES & REGULATIONS FOR USE OF RI'S SPORTS FACILITIES

- ORA members are required to show their membership card upon being requested to do so by the security of the school.
- Smoking within the entire school campus is disallowed under the Smoking (Prohibition in Certain Places)(Amendment) Notification 1997, both indoors and outdoors. The school authorities and security guards reserve the right to summon the authorities in the event that this condition is violated.
- Gambling is disallowed and all forms of alcohol are not allowed to be consumed on the premises. Pets (including those on leashes or in vehicles) are also not allowed to be brought into the school.
- Persons coming into the school premises must be properly attired and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times. Spiked shoes are not to be worn on the astroturf and artificial turf.
- The school's electrical supply or water supply should not be tapped upon without permission. The playing of music, which will disturb the students residing in the RI Boarding School, is also disallowed.
- The facilities and premises should be kept clean and tidy. Groups who have been found to have littered or dirtied the school premises may be barred from future use. Please report any damage to the facilities either to the security guard upon discovery.
- Notices, posters and banners, either outside or in the school, should not be displayed without prior approval .
- Please only park in the lots designated for visitors and the school's traffic and instructions by the security guards should be observed at all times and parking in Raffles Square is prohibited.
- Pets or animals (leashed or unleashed), should not be brought into the school premises at all times. Security guards or the school's representatives reserve the right to request ORA members to leave the school campus if this clause has been violated.
